

University Housing has been providing hall accommodations and services for campus summer camps and programs for more than 80 years. Residence halls are updated regularly to provide a comfortable, safe, convenient on-campus living environment. All campus residence halls are non-smoking facilities.

Room Amenities

Furnishings

The University Residence Halls offer comfortable, "student-style" rooms. Our residence halls provide:

- Small refrigerator
- Dressers or shelving
- Bookcase
- Desks and desk chairs
- Single (twin-size) beds with pillows and bed linens

Housekeeping

- Daily housekeeping services of common areas (bathrooms, hallways, floor lounges) are provided.
- Guests staying in traditional halls may desire additional housekeeping service in guest rooms. Guest rooms can be cleaned and towels, soap, tissues, and drinking cups provided for an additional charge. This option should be discussed with your professional conference planner.
- We support the conservation efforts of campus and the community by encouraging recycling, and asking that guests to good stewards of resources by reducing waste.

Air Conditioning

During the summer conference season, all residence hall rooms are air conditioned.

Televisions and Cable TV

- All guest rooms are cable-ready. For guests who bring their own televisions and cable, cable TV is provided at no additional charge.
- Live digital television streams can be viewed on a guest's computer via the campus Digital Academic Television Network (DATN). Current channels include ABC, CBS, NBC, FOX, CNN, The Weather Channel and a variety of news and foreign language channels.

Internet Service

All guest rooms provide wired high-speed Internet access at no additional charge. Floor dens and common areas provide wireless access.

Safety and Security

- Our security system features security/surveillance cameras at building entrances.
- All exterior doors feature a newly updated card access system so that doors stay locked; only authorized guests have access to the residence halls.

Accessibility

Most University Residence Halls are accessible to guests with physical disabilities. Advance notice allows us to best assist you.

Smoke Free

For the comfort of all guests, all guest rooms and campus buildings are smoke-free.

Technology Centers

Kronshage Hall features a technology center that provides complimentary open use of both PC and Mac computers. Centers may be reserved for classes with the Conference Services staff.

Lounges

Floor lounges provide televisions, telephones, and a casual, comfortable area to socialize and relax.

Bathrooms

Each hall contains "down the hall" common bathrooms with private shower and changing areas.

Meeting & Conference Rooms

Meeting rooms and floor lounges with AV equipment can be reserved at no additional charge. Guest rooms can be used as your on-site office, staff area, or storage.

Equipment

The following equipment is available:

- Portable public address/sound systems for indoor use
- Microphones (handheld, lapel, wired, and wireless) and microphone stands
- Projectors and screens
- Televisions, television carts, DVD players and VCR units
- Boom boxes with radio, cassette tape and CD players
- Dry-erase and chalkboards
- Easels for flip charts
- Podiums (table top and floor)
